Application Procedure:

About the Scholarship:

The Brian Kinney '91 Memorial Scholarship has been established by John Sullivan '91, the Bishop Guertin class of 1991, as well as Brian's family and friends.

Brian Kinney was an active student at Bishop Guertin and involved in many clubs, activities, and sports. Most notably, Brian had a passion and love for baseball. In 2001, Brian was working as a manager in the Global Risk Management Solutions at PricewaterhouseCooper LLP, in Boston, Massachusetts. On September 11, 2001, Brian boarded United Airlines Flight 175 in Boston and was bound for Los Angeles to meet with a client. Brian's flight was hijacked and tragically flown into the World Trade Center's South Tower on that fateful morning. It is in his memory and his compassion for others that this scholarship has been established.

The recipient should have been at Bishop Guertin for at least one year, entering his/her sophomore, junior, or senior year, and must have demonstrated financial need. Ideally, applicants should hold a minimum GPA of 3.0 and be considered a member of the community in good standing, meaning the recipient should represent the core values of Bishop Guertin, both in and out of the classroom. When possible, consideration may be given to a member/participant of the BG Baseball/Softball program, without regard for athletic potential.
