Application Procedure:

About the Scholarship:

This scholarship was established by a Bishop Guertin Family to honor their late infant daughter Kailyn who would have been a member of the Class of 2018. It is intended to serve as a model for the "pay it forward" ideal as the family has always believed in giving and paying it forward. - 3. Describe a time you overcame a challenge or an obstacle. This can be academic, social, family, or personal. Please explain what you learned from this experience and/or how it may (or may not) have changed you.
