Application Procedure:

4. **DEADLINE for submission: Friday, February 11, 2022 by 3:00 PM**
5. The scholarship recipient will be announced at the annual Green and Gold Academic Awards or equivalent ceremonies.

About the Scholarship:

This scholarship was established by the family of Lorraine Alice Hamilton, a Board Member and active volunteer both in and out of Bishop Guertin High School for many years. Lorraine was an emergency and critical care nurse as well as a trained social worker. She lived her life serving others and was often referred to as an “angel among us”. Continually giving to others, Lorraine shared her healing heart and hands to those in need both near and far. Both of Lorraine’s sons, Ryan Hamilton ’97 and Todd Hamilton ’01 are graduates of Bishop Guertin. Although Lorraine was a compassionate nurse who went above and beyond the care a nurse typically provides, she will be especially remembered as a true and valued friend. With her graceful demeanor, devoted attention, and her gift for actively listening to others, she was a friend for life. She was a kind individual who chose to focus on the gifts and talents of each person she touched. Lorraine’s passing was an enormous loss to all who knew and loved her; however, her legacy and life lessons she taught us will forever help and encourage the next generation of health care providers.

Criteria:

Two (2) scholarships in the amount of \$2,500 each will be awarded. The first, to a **graduating senior** who must be a student in good standing, who has been accepted into a 2-or 4-year college with a declared major in the healthcare field or demonstrated interest in the healthcare industry. **Graduating Seniors should complete the application and answer the following question: Why do you want to work in the healthcare industry? What qualities and traits do you have which will be an asset to the field?**

The second, a **returning student** must be a current student in good academic standing. The ideal student should be able to display financial need. When possible, consideration may be given to a student whose parent(s) work in the healthcare field. **Returning students interested in applying for this scholarship must be willing to answer the following question: What can you do, as a high school student, to positively influence school culture, helping your friends and peers become the very best versions of themselves?**

Both of these awards come with the expectation that when the recipient is able, he/she will pay it forward and help the next generation of Cardinals.
