## COVID INSTRUCTION

Bishop Guertin High School maintained live instruction throughout the pandemic. During the spring of 2020, students participated virtually in their scheduled live classes via videoconferencing. Classroom assessment and assignments continued and the school's grading scale was maintained. In 2020-2021, Bishop Guertin implemented a flexible plan and offered mostly in-person instruction, with hybrid and remote options at limited times depending on local conditions. In 2021-2022, instruction was entirely in-person. At all times, the academic development and whole-person formation of our school program has been continued.
