# **HONOR AWARDS**

## **THEOLOGY AWARD**

The Theology Award is presented to the senior who exhibits a knowledge of the Christian message as presented in the classroom. This senior consistently demonstrates leadership and service to the academic faith community and to fellow human beings.

## **ENGLISH AWARD**

The English Award is presented to the senior who displays exemplary scholarship in the English language. This senior exhibits mastery of the art of writing, possesses sound knowledge of grammatical norms and principles, and has acquired an appreciation of literature.

## **MATHEMATICS AWARD**

The Mathematics Award is presented to the senior who demonstrates a mastery of algebra, geometry, trigonometry, and calculus.

## **SOCIAL STUDIES AWARD**

The Social Studies Award is presented to the senior who is acutely aware of current world events and economics and who demonstrates a comprehensive understanding of the development of history and cultural heritage.

## **SCIENCE AWARDS**

The Science Awards are presented to seniors who exhibit remarkable scientific knowledge and understanding of the principles of biology, chemistry, and physics.

## **WORLD LANGUAGE AWARDS**

The World Language Awards are presented to seniors who possess a mastery of either the French, Spanish, or Latin language, customs, and heritage.

## **FINE ARTS AWARDS**

The Fine Arts Awards are presented to seniors who have participated in the study of art or music. These students demonstrate self-motivation, talent, and dedication to the pursuit of excellence and are recognized in both co-curricular activities and in state and national competitions.

## **COMPUTER SCIENCE AWARD**

The Computer Science Award is presented to the senior who exhibits exceptional achievement in Computer Science. This student consistently demonstrates leadership by using this knowledge to benefit the school community.

# **HONOR AWARDS**

## **HEALTH AND FITNESS AWARD**

The Health and Fitness Department recognizes a senior that has shown positive participation in the Health and Fitness curriculum cultivating the appreciation of lifetime values and demonstrating the importance of cooperation, leadership, and personal commitment. This student also advocates for values through participation in physical activity and an awareness of wellness issues within a healthy lifestyle.

## **AP CAPSTONE AWARD**

The AP Capstone Program consists of coursework which engages students in cross-curricular research that explores the complexities of academic and real-world topics and issues by considering divergent perspectives. The culmination of the program requires students to conduct a year-long, independent research project on topics of their choosing. This award is presented to a student who demonstrates mastery in research, collaboration, and written and oral communication.

## **THE THOMAS SULLIVAN MEMORIAL SCHOLAR-ATHLETE AWARDS**

The Scholar-Athlete Awards are presented to one male and one female senior who are the commendable and enviable combination of outstanding scholars and fine athletes. The Scholar-Athlete Awards are given in memory of Thomas Sullivan.

## **THE LARRY ELLIOTT LOYALTY AWARD**

The Larry Elliott Loyalty Award is given in loving memory of Larry Elliott, a friend, benefactor, and parent of six BG alumni. It is presented to a senior whose dedication and loyalty to Guertin cannot adequately be expressed in words. This senior is chosen by the faculty and staff and exemplifies dedication and loyalty through both curricular and co-curricular activities. Again this year, this award is presented with a scholarship. Due to the many successful years of holding the Larry Elliott Sportsmen's Dinner, a portion of the proceeds have been designated to establish the Larry Elliott Loyalty Award Scholarship while the balance of the fund continues to support the development and maintenance of the Elliott Fields at Bishop Guertin High School.

## **THE ALL GUERTIN AWARD**

The All Guertin Award is given in memory of Joseph P. LaBrecque. This award is the most prestigious award offered to a senior and is presented to a student who enjoys the respect of the entire school community. This senior is an outstanding student who is dedicated to learning, has participated in interscholastic activities, and has given service to the school and community.
