BISHOP GUERTIN IN BRIEF

Founded in 1963, Bishop Guertin High School is a private, independent, Roman Catholic college-preparatory high school for young men and women of all faiths that draws students from 34 towns in southern New Hampshire and 22 towns in Massachusetts. Admission to the school is based on the results of admission testing and competitive academics. Present enrollment is about 775 students in Grades 9-12.

- **Demanding Curriculum:** Bishop Guertin students are immersed in a challenging academic environment from freshman year, focusing on advanced reading and writing skills. Every student is expected to meet high academic standards, particularly in reading and writing.
- **Achieved Advancement:** Advanced course invitations are contingent on exemplary performance in prior courses.
- **Skill Development:** We instill essential soft skills like time management, critical thinking, and effective communication, ensuring our students are well-prepared for academic life in college. Our students arrive at college not only in proficient in the above skills, but also additional skills like self-advocacy, integrity, and perseverance.
- **Holistic Formation:** Our students are also inspired to be well-rounded individuals, actively engaging in athletic, spiritual, and social facets of life.
- **Proven Success Metrics:** Bishop Guertin alumni complete their Bachelor's degrees at a rate faster than the national average, while serving as academic leaders in their college communities, and often achieve success early in their careers.
